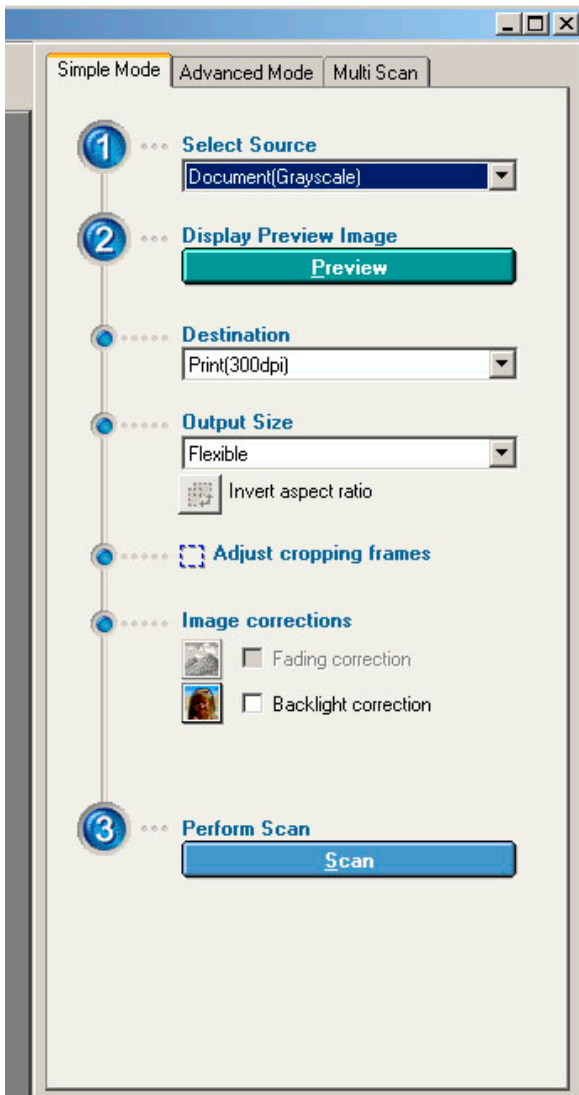
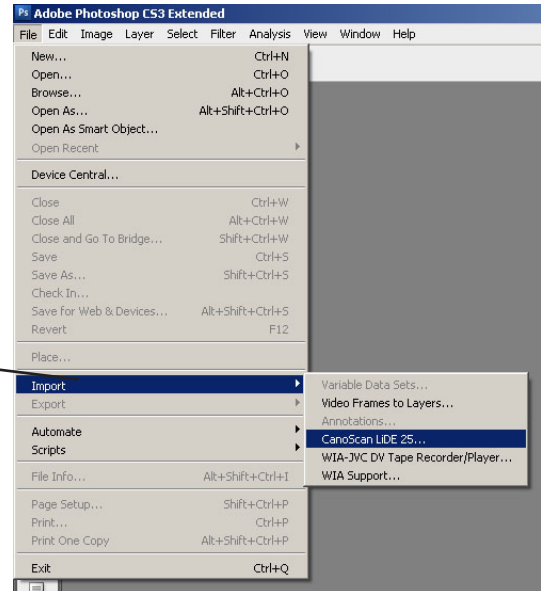

# Scanning

1. Plug In Scanner to available USB point on the computer.
2. Open Photoshop
3. In Photoshop, Go to File Menu > Import > CanoScan LiDE25

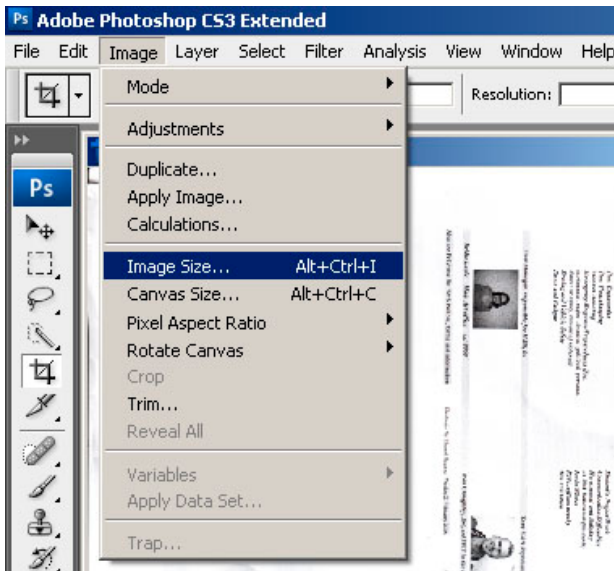


- 4 a) **Select Source** from drop down menu
- b) click **PREVIEW**
- c) **Destination** i.e. what resolution do you want the final/destination file to be?
- d) Choose **Output Size** e.g. A4
- e) Crop if necessary i.e. if you only want to a bit of the page/image.
- f) **SCAN**
- g) Close ScanGear Window

# Scanning



**To Save a copy for Print/Archive**  
(You should have scanned at 300dpi)

5. (In Photoshop) File Menu>SAVE  
a) choose TIFF [print copy]

**To Save a copy for Internet/e-mailing**

6. Image Menu>Image Size  
a) Change to 72dpi
7. File Menu > Save AS  
a) choose JPEG [online copy]
