0	Introductory Seminar: taking your first step
Send invitation to join online live blog via email	<p>This event is similar to a chat event but does not require the download of any software. It enables a group to follow a brief presentation/discussion in text and to participate by asking questions and following the links.</p> <p>During this event participants are introduced to the concept of an elearning journey, provided with a road map; a set of milestones; an overview of their destination and outcomes; plus an opportunity to collaborate on the design of their own</p> <p>‘Elearning Initiatives: embedding innovative practice’</p> <p>Participants will be shown how to add a page of their own in the wiki for their own reflections. (Note: if preferred a link to their own blogs can be used here.)</p>

June 12	<p>Participants to add a reply to the first discussion topic ‘Taking your first step’</p> <p>Participants to reflect on this experience in their own page.</p> <p>“Discovery.”</p>
