You put this in the right tense

I am having

He/She is having

PRESENT PERFECT

He/She has had

I/You/We/They have had

PAST SIMPLE

I/etc. had

PAST CONTINUOUS

I/He/She was having
We/You/They were having

PAST PERFECT

I/etc. had had

FUTURE SIMPLE

I/etc. will have

FUTURE CONTINUOUS

I/etc. will be having

FUTURE PERFECT

I/etc. will have had

GOING TO

I <mark>am going to have</mark>

He/She is going to have

We/You/They are going to have

MODALS

CAN/COULD/MAY/MIGHT/
SHALL/ SHOULD/OUGHT TO/WILL/
