

# **TRU-OL Certificate in General Studies**

#### **Summary:**

- 30 credit certificate program comprised entirely of elective credits in any subject area; 1st year equivalent or higher;
- Maximum of 15 'applied' credits (ie. Vocational, studio, PLAR, etc.)
- Residency Requirement: up to 24 credits can be transferred into this certificate, with a minimum of 6 TRU credits (distance or face-to-face) included in the certificate program to meet minimum TRU residency requirements;
- Education, business, and administrative studies courses are reviewed on a case-bycase basis; academic/theoretical courses in these areas are usually approved (most typically fall under this category); however, ABT-type programs, practicums, etc. would fall under 'applied credit.'

- Review all course outlines (use a basic template)
- Once course-for-course or 'applied' credits are articulated, build information into our system (Banner) to recognize approved OERu courses;
- Building on the Certificate, TRU-OL students could ladder into diploma and degree
