

Dear translators,

Using Notepad++ is using a powerful tool but it can also do powerful damage.

Web pages, which end in htm for us, and html for some others, have most of their controls and commands in tags. A tag is something which usually follows the sign `<` and is ended by the sign `>`

An example would be `` which turns on the Bold function, and `` which turns Bold off again.

Other tags may be a series of four or five characters beginning with the sign `&`

When you are using Notepad++ to edit web pages, you will see all the tags, unlike when you use CatsCradle.

Please be very careful to avoid deleting any tags or parts of tags on a web page when you are editing (i.e. translating) the text content.
