COURSE DESCRIPTION

YEAR III SEMESTER VI

HEC 361 : Community Nutrition and Health (2 Credits)

The course involves factors that determine the nutritional status of a community; nutritional screening, nutritional assessment methods and the role of national and international agencies in the nutrition programmes of Ghana. It helps students to understand the relationships between nutrition and health; diet related diseases and their management. The HIV/AIDS epidemic, STD's, Drug Abuse, and Habits that promote healthy living within the community.

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HEC 362: Entrepreneurship Education and Costing (3 Credits)

This course is designed to provide the student with a general understanding of entrepreneurship studies. It provides a broad overview of the entrepreneur as a team leader in a group of other experts. It focuses on simple cost accounting techniques used in the analysis of business operations for decision making. It provides an introduction to some costing methods employed in business place and aims at developing skills for using cost accounting as a tool for planning, budgeting and decision making in the business environment and personal life.

HEC 363: Practice in Family Living (3 Credits)

The course prepares students to learn to live with others, shut and open a house, receive and entertain visitors for various occasions. Students shall be required to carry out individual or group projects in areas of management and write report on resource use, work organization and use of time in relation to household organization.

HEC 364: Advanced Clothing Construction (2 Credits)

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This course involves a field study of traditional dressmaking, seminars on issues of Ghanaian dressmaking practices. It also provides information on how to set up a clothing business. The course covers advanced professional techniques in sewing, and direct cutting techniques.

HEC 365 : Garment Construction (3 Credits)

The course is designed to introduce students to garment designing, pattern construction, laying and cutting out. and the making up of garments.

HEC 367 : Applied Food and Nutrition (2 credits) ?

The course exposes students to how to prepare a lesson plan for teaching various topics in home economics at the pre-tertiary educational level to suit a particular age group or class and select the appropriate teaching learning materials for the topic.
