Workshop: Digital Cameras – taking images/downloading/opening and Photoshop basic edits (opening/saving/re-sizing/cropping/rotating.)

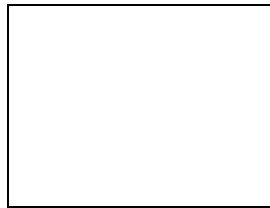
