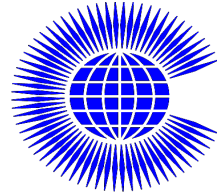

Report of the

**FACE-2-FACE WikiEducator and OER Training
Workshop**

25th- 27th June 2008

Introduction

The Commonwealth Youth Programme Regional Centre for Africa (CYP RCA), under the Youth Enterprise and Sustainable Livelihoods (YESL) programme held a face to face WikiEducator and OER training at Zambia Centre for Accountancy studies (ZCAS). This was a result of two OER meetings held at CYP in April and May 2008 with heads of institutions and Information Technology section supervisors from various educational institutions in Lusaka.

Training Objectives

The objectives of the training were to:

- Share knowledge on what new/innovative applications can be derived from existing technologies
- Explore the concept of open source software/technologies
- Understand the meaning and use of Wikis,
- Introduce participants to specific education applications such as WE and Moodle

The training:

The three days training started on 25th June 2008. Mr. Billy Kahoota gave an opening remark; he invited everyone at ZCAS and provided the objectives of the training. He then invited the training facilitator; Mr. Victor Mensah to take over the session.

Participants expressed their expectations to which most of them reflected the training objectives. Then day one session started where the facilitator took the participants through the concepts of open source technologies, Wiki and WikiEducator. Also participants were able to create WikiEducator accounts as well as learning basic text formatting skills.

Day one session ended by self assessment exercises and after that, lab work followed where participants were able to work on their own contents.

Day two training objectives were to enable trainees create new pages, links and to introduce the syntax for adding images as well as providing an overview of more detailed image formatting. At the end of the day, participants were able to upload images from the computer to their wiki pages. They also learned about collaborative editing.

On the last day, participants learned about WikiEducator pedagogical templates. The objectives of this lesson were to explain the concept of using “iDevices” as sub-elements of elements of an educational resource, also to revisit template syntax and view examples of pedagogical templates with corresponding tips. After that participants were able to do exercises on Wiki structures and free content.

Outcomes of the Training:

- All participants have acquired knowledge on Wikis and open source technologies in general.
- Every participant has a WikiEducator account.
- Most participants have been certified as qualified Wikibuddys
- Participants are able to send messages to one another; this means they are now able to share knowledge and information.

Conclusion:

The training was successful and most importantly the training objectives were met. Participants expressed their gratitude to CYP and ZCAS for organizing the event. According to them the training was an eye opener and they admitted that, the knowledge attained will go a long way in ensuring learning process is simplified not only to teachers but also to students.
