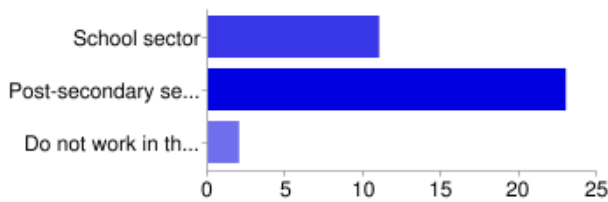

In which education sector do you work?



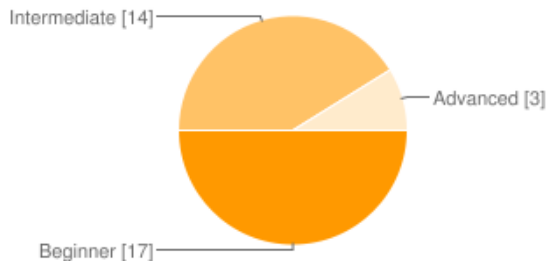
School sector

How would you rate your knowledge of the Open Education Resources (OER) concept PRIOR to the workshop?

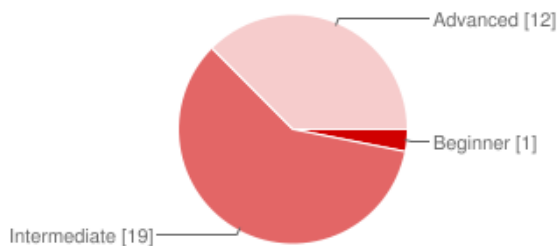

How would you rate your knowledge of the Open Education Resource (OER) concept AFTER the workshop?

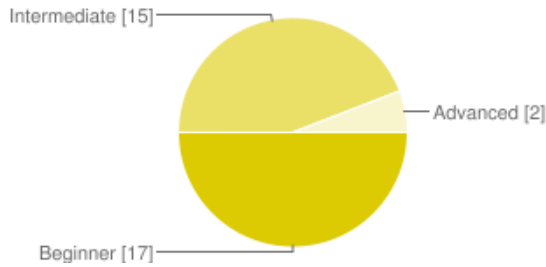

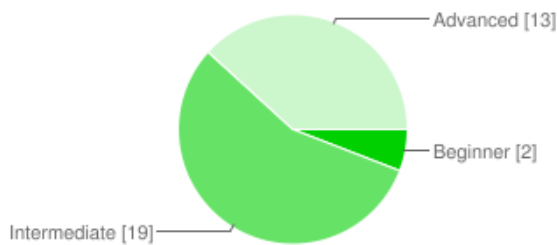

**How did you rate your knowledge of Creative Commons licenses PRIOR to the workshop?**



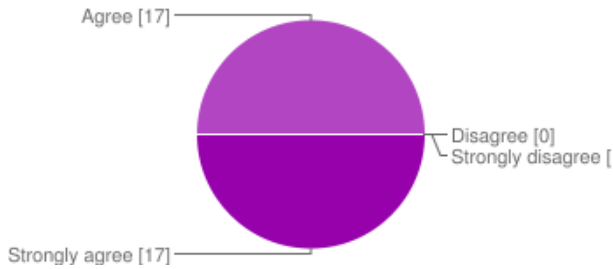

**How would you rate your knowledge of Creative Commons licenses AFTER the workshop?**



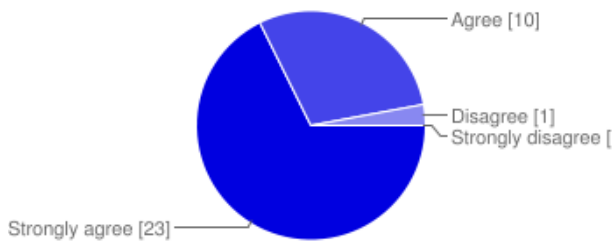

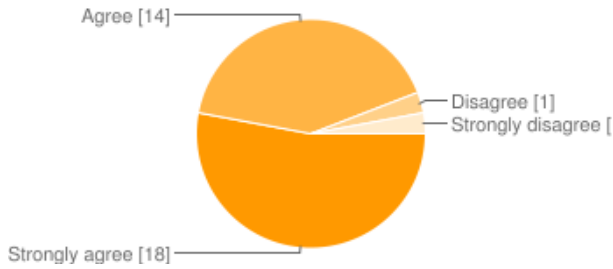

**The OCL4ED course materials are relevant**



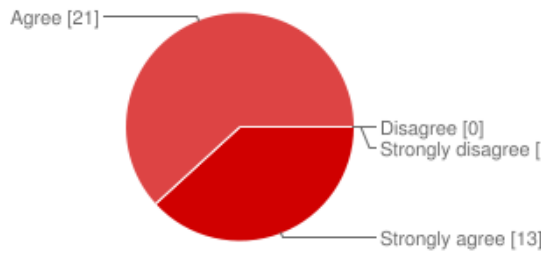

**The OCL4ED course materials are well organised**



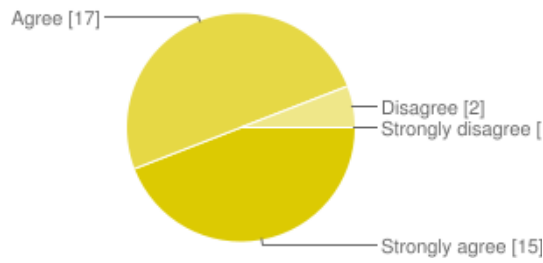

**Instructions for the learning activities are clear**



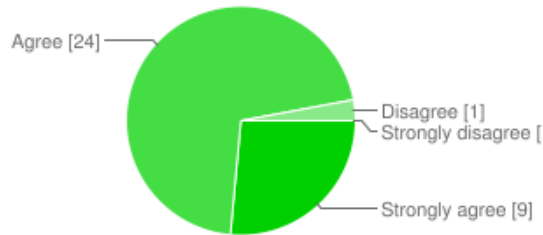

**The learning activities are interesting**



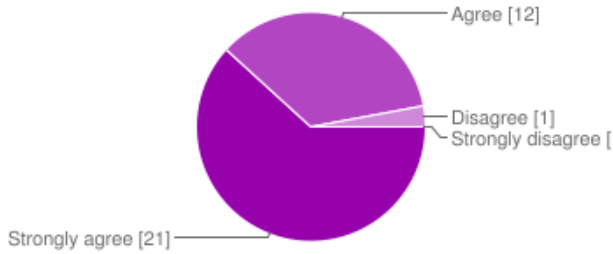

**The difficulty level of the OCL4ED course was appropriate for me**



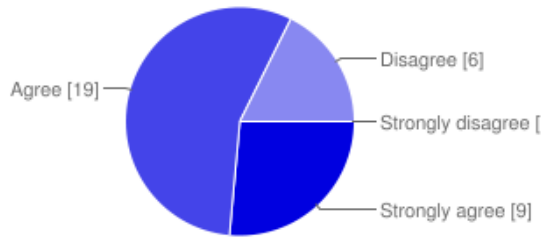

**I would recommend the OCL4ED workshop to others**



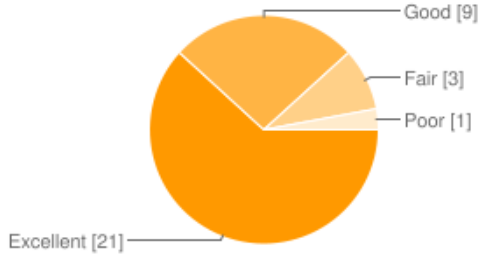

**I felt "connected" with fellow participants in the OCL4ED course**



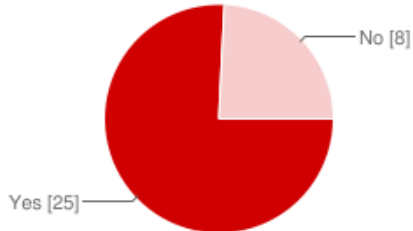

**How would you rate the overall quality of the OCL4ED workshop?**



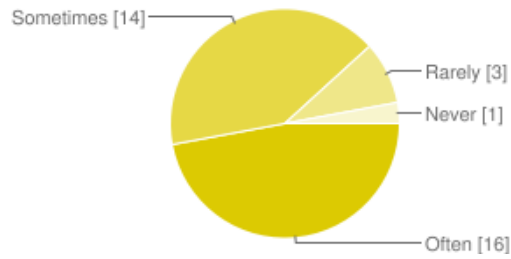

**Did you post any notes using the microblog (identi.ca) feature of the OCL4ED course?**



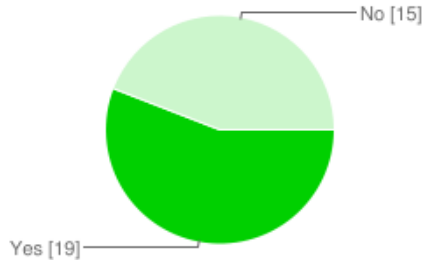

**How often did you read and/or follow the microblog (identi.ca) posts from the workshop participants?**



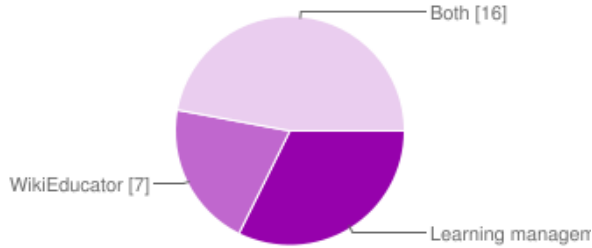

**Did you post any discussions in the Moodle discussion forums for the course?**



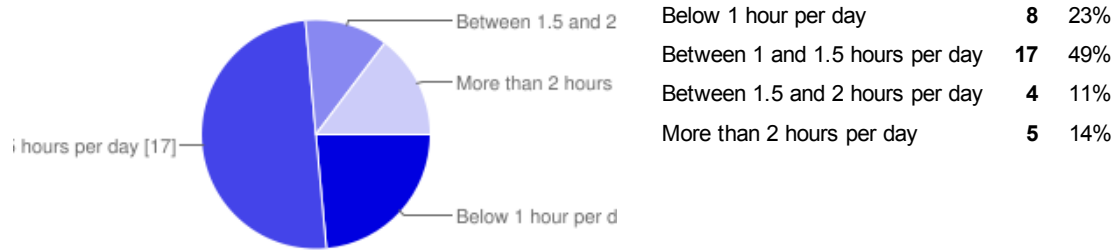

More examples and exemplary problems. Animated lessons, too, needed. I think it should be reorganized based ...
