

How do baselines and goals relate properly?

When stating baselines be factual and show what the student is capable of doing at the present time.

Stating the baseline

1. ANNUAL GOAL (Form A)

Area of Need: Reading

Goal Baseline:
In 3 trials Raul is able to read at the 3rd grade level and can recall 40% of what he reads when using a reading comprehension questionnaire

Measurable Annual Goal:

Annotations: 1 points to the title, 2 points to the Area of Need, 3 points to the Goal Baseline.

1. Using the **"Goals"** page from the SEIS IEP
2. State the Area of Need in the subject matter being measured
3. State the baseline in measurable terms which can be used to show progress as the goals are being reviewed.

Connecting the Goal to the baseline

11. ANNUAL GOAL (Form A)

Area of Need: Reading

Goal Baseline:
In 3 trials Raul is able to read at the 3rd grade level and can recall 40% of what he reads when using a reading comprehension questionnaire

Measurable Annual Goal:
By 01/23/2013, in 3 consecutive trials, when asked questions about a reading a 3rd grade passage, Raul, will recall 80% of what he has read when using a reading comprehension questionnaire.

Yellow arrows connect the goal text to the baseline text.

In this illustration, the goals for Raul relate to the baseline and can be measured for progress and growth.

Ready for Progress Report

Progress Reports:

Each service provider shall complete the progress report section on the goal page for each of their goals to be included in the Progress Report.

1. Check the check box next to the goals that Progress info needs to be completed on and then click the Write Progress button.
2. Use that page to write progress info for multiple goals and mark them as ready for PR if applicable.
3. Click on the Update link in the Ready for PR column to indicate if the goal will be included in the affirmed Progress Report (if this step was skipped when writing progress info for the goals).

Only Goals that are marked with a Yes will be included in the affirmed Progress Report when the Case Manager clicks on the Affirm Progress Report button.

If the process is followed appropriately, the progress report steps are relatively easy to complete.
