4	<p><b>Headings and Subheadings</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use equal signs on either side of the heading text</li> </ul> <p>Note: If your content has at least 4 headings, a table of contents will be automatically generated for you.</p>	<p>==type heading here==</p> <p>===type sub-heading here===</p> <p>====type sub-sub-heading here====</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Etc.</p>
5	<p><b>Indenting text</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use colon(s) before typing the word you wish to indent</li> </ul> <p>Note: Type these without a space in the first character position of a new line</p>	<p>: type word(s) here</p> <p>:: and here</p> <p>::: and here</p>

6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bulleted list</li> <li>• Use an asterisk * before the list</li> </ul>	<p>*type word(s) here for 1<sup>st</sup> bullet  *and here for 2<sup>nd</sup> bullet  **and here for a subset of 2<sup>nd</sup> b.  *and here for the 3<sup>rd</sup> bullet</p>

9	<p><b>For internal links</b> i.e. to link to another page which is within wikieducator</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• use double square brackets</li> </ul> <p>Note: When linking to a page within wikieducator there is no need to type <a href="http://www.wikieducator.org">www.wikieducator.org</a></p> <p>Just type the name of the page.</p>	<p>[[type name of page here]]</p> <p>OR</p> <p>[[type name of page type title you wish public to see]]</p>

10	<p><b>For external links</b> – i.e. to link to another page outside of wikieducator</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• type the website url without brackets (The website address will be displayed) OR</li> <li>• type the website address between single square brackets (the link will be displayed as a number in brackets like this [1]. This format is mostly used for citing sources within an article, OR</li> <li>• type in the website address leave a space then type the text you wish the public to see i.e website name or description. What appears is the text not the website address. 17	<p>To insert media files e.g. videos, audio, pdf docs.</p> <p>Note: You add attributes to media in the same manner as for images</p>	<pre>[[media:type filename]]</pre>
18	To insert an iDevice or pedagogical template use double curly brackets	<pre>{{type in template name here}}</pre>
